



#### From the desk of the pastor...

The Gospel of this **17th Sunday** (Jn. 6, 1-15) shows us the true remedy for stress and pressure and the balm for a weary body and spirit – that is the ability to withdraw. The Gospel is about the great miracle of the multiplication of the loaves. Wow! But the Gospel ends with the line: "He withdrew again to the mountain alone." Make that a double wow!

Any gambler can tell you that the secret to "success" is the ability to stop and withdraw while one is still on a roll. On the same count, any gambler – often in hindsight and with much regret – can also tell you that ambition and greed caused their folly and downfall.

You and I have our share of regrets, too, when we could and should have withdrawn or stopped. The lure of money, power, pride and pleasure is such a strong force that can only be neutralized by true and deep prayer. That is why those who have much in this life must also pray much. Otherwise, someday, they will pay much.

It is interesting to note that Jesus often withdrew from the crowd to be with His disciples. But beyond that, He also withdrew from His disciples to be with the Father. I am sure Jesus also consulted with and listened to His disciples, but the final and definitive reckoning was always done with the Father, in prayer.

Let us make sure that we really listen to God, and not to ourselves, or to people who may be well-meaning but, more often than not, have their own agenda in mind. "Discernment" is a big word today. To be "discerning" is important, but to be a "discerning disciple" is more important; emphasis on "disciple." Why? Because being a disciple presupposes a master. The bottom line is that there is only one Lord and Master. Again, let us listen deep and wide to Him who speaks to us externally in people, events and in the "signs of the times"; and, also and especially so, in sincere, humble prayer at the feet of the Master.

Lord, help me to discern when to pursue and when to withdraw.

# Update to Lockdown Measures



The Ontario provincial government announced that the province will be moving into Step 3 of the Reopening Strategy as of 12:01 a.m., Friday July 16, 2021.

In Step 3, there is no capacity limit for churches and missions. However, physical distancing of 2 metres (6 feet) is still required between parishioners attending Mass who are not from the same household.

There is no need for contact tracing at the services in the church or mission unless there is a funeral. (See the section below for funerals.)

- Currently, face mask use indoors is mandatory for the celebrants and the faithful, even for those who are fully vaccinated.
- Congregational singing is not permitted in Step 3.
- A cantor or small choir may be utilized if singers/musicians are 3 metres from one another and any member of the congregation. Singers/musicians from the same household do not have to distance themselves from one another.
- One altar server or two or more altar servers from the same household are permitted at a Mass. Face masks must be worn, and physical distancing maintained.
- The celebrant's regular practice for greeting parishioners and processing at the beginning and the end of the liturgy may resume with adherence to the health precautions.

#### **FUNERALS**

For funerals in Step 3, the Bereavement Authority of Ontario has issued the following guidelines:

#### Indoor Funeral Services

Indoor funeral services are permitted with the physical distancing of two metres (six feet) between people.

Contact tracing information must be collected. Records must be kept for 30 days.

All attendees and staff must adhere to local public health unit restrictions.


