



From the desk of the pastor...

Life is about survival. The desire to live in spite of setbacks. Many sick patients recover and continue to live because they desire to live. They love life and live it to the fullest. They never give up on themselves or others. Most of all, they have faith in God.

Today's Gospel of John deepens the theme of life and hope. Jesus Christ, the Son of God, came down from Heaven, to draw all people to God. He offers us the "bread from heaven, which alone is able to satisfy the deepest of all human hungers, the hunger for life. Jesus is the one offering us life, offering new meaning and purpose, offering new hope. As food for our journey, He offers His very self.

He reminds us that the manna in the desert provided nourishment only for a day, not for eternity. But the bread of Jesus gives life forever. If we feed on Christ, if we believe in Him and learn from Him, His life will become part of our life.

Jesus offers to let us participate in His life now. He invites us to be part of Him, for He wants His flesh to give life to the world now. He seeks to help people on their journey towards God, towards fullness of life, to sustain people, to offer new hope, to bring purpose and confidence to a bruised and often battered people.

The "Bread of Life" is a gift freely given, not because we are the holiest of people but because we are trying to be holy in spite of the troubles and struggles we experience along the way. In the words of the psalmist, we are able to "Taste and see that the Lord is good."

<u>Update to Lockdown</u> Measures



The Ontario provincial government announced that the province will be moving into Step 3 of the Reopening Strategy as of 12:01 a.m., Friday July 16, 2021.

In Step 3, there is no capacity limit for churches and missions. However, physical distancing of 2 metres (6 feet) is still required between parishioners attending Mass who are not from the same household.

There is no need for contact tracing at the services in the church or mission unless there is a funeral. (See the section below for funerals.)

- Currently, face mask use indoors is mandatory for the celebrants and the faithful, even for those who are fully vaccinated.
- Congregational singing is not permitted in Step 3.
- A cantor or small choir may be utilized if singers/musicians are 3
 metres from one another and any member of the
 congregation. Singers/musicians from the same household do
 not have to distance themselves from one another.
- One altar server or two or more altar servers from the same household are permitted at a Mass. Face masks must be worn, and physical distancing maintained.
- The celebrant's regular practice for greeting parishioners and processing at the beginning and the end of the liturgy may resume with adherence to the health precautions.

FUNERALS

For funerals in Step 3, the Bereavement Authority of Ontario has issued the following guidelines:

Indoor Funeral Services

Indoor funeral services are permitted with the physical distancing of two metres (six feet) between people.

Contact tracing information must be collected. Records must be kept for 30 days.

All attendees and staff must adhere to local public health unit restrictions.
