


From the desk of the pastor...

Blessed day to all!

As we prepare ourselves for a joint celebration of our deceased loved ones in our Catholic Cemetery on Sunday, September 26, 2021 at 11 am, I thought of sharing with you a short history of our cemetery. It's short but a very interesting scope of information.

The cemetery is located on Lot 23, Concession 3, on land donated by Patrick Cook in 1885. The record of blessing was as follows:

> "On July 11, Bishop Dowling of Peterborough, assisted by his secretary, Father Keilty of Ennismore, Father McCloskey of Victoria Road and the pastor, Father McEvay, blessed the Cemetery."

> "The cross at the end of St. Peter's Avenue was erected by Mr. Jeremiah Twomey. In days gone by, the men of Fenelon Falls and Bobcaygeon frequented the cemetery twice each year to spend a day cutting weeds, levelling and filling graves and generally maintaining the grounds."

"In 1973, Mr. Robert Stone is the caretaker."

When I arrived here in July 2018, it was Michael Byrne, assisted by Michael Jr., who looked after the upkeep and maintenance of the cemetery. However, a Cemetery Board was formed to help in the allotment and maintenance of the grounds used for burials and for grave preparation.

My heartfelt thanks to our Cemetery Board including Brian McIlhargey, Dan Burnie, Bob Heenan, Mike Byrne and Walter Sweeney for a great and wonderful job they have done for both churches. And, they have done it very well and for "free".
