



Update to Lockdown Measures

CHURCH SERVICES & PARISH HALLS

Churches and Parish Halls can be opened for services, meetings/events observing the following guidelines: Participants will wear a face covering, physical distancing between participants/households of 6 feet (2 metres) will be maintained, no food will be served.

VACCINE PASSPORT

The province of Ontario is instituting a Vaccine Passport. The Vaccine Passport is not required for places of worship where a religious celebration is taking place. However, the Vaccine Passport is required in "meeting and event spaces."

VACCINE POLICY

All clergy and employees serving in the Diocese of Peterborough as well as vendors providing contracted services are encouraged to receive the Covid-19 vaccine. If clergy and employees are partially or not vaccinated, they must submit weekly a negative Covid rapid test to carry out their duties. Volunteers must likewise be fully vaccinated or submit a current negative Covid rapid test to fulfill their ministry. (Rapid tests, however, will not be accepted from Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, who must be fully vaccinated to carry out their ministry.) These provisions are temporary and will continue only for as long as the Vaccination Policy is in effect.

Synod of Bishops - "Communion, Participation and Mission."

Pope Francis has announced that in preparation for the next Synod of Bishops, there will be a worldwide conversation in the Church or a "synod" about community, engaged participation and the mission of evangelization. This conversation will follow a two-year path and involve the People of God - everyone, everywhere.

The first phase of the conversation begins on October 17th at 10:30 a.m. when +Most Reverend Bishop Miehm will celebrate a Mass at the Cathedral of St. Peter-in-Chains. This celebration roots the synod in prayer, sacrament and community. This Mass will also be live-streamed and available throughout the Diocese. All are invited to join in prayer as we begin this synodal conversation and unite it with the Diocesan Pastoral Planning Process.

The Diocesan Pastoral Planning Committee is launching a survey inviting the input of all the People of God and this input will be part of both the worldwide and local conversations to establish pastoral priorities within the Church. More details will follow and please - look for the survey link and provide the benefit of your experience and your hopes for the Church - local and universal.


