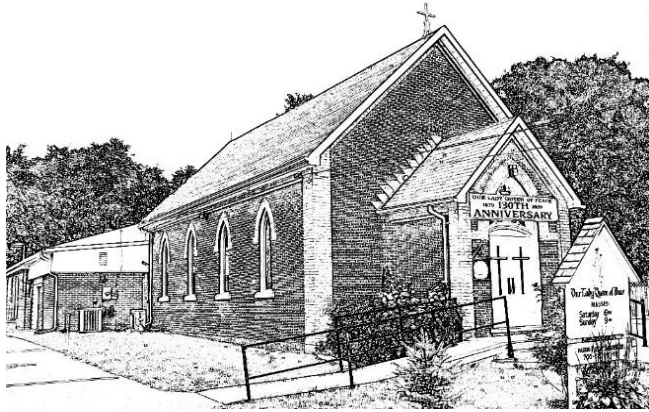

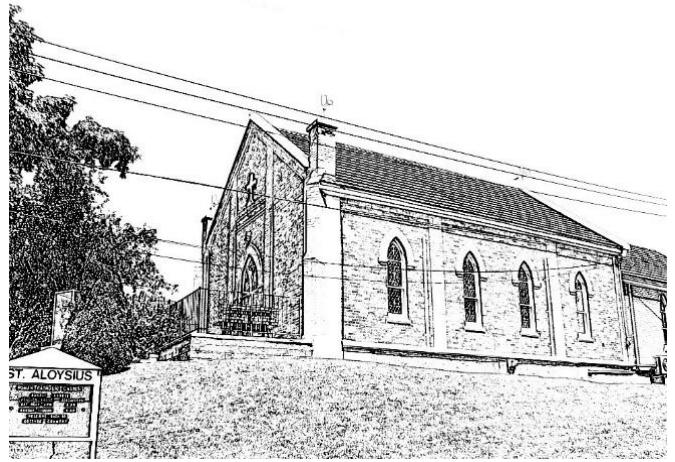

**From the desk of the pastor...**

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ is the most important event in salvation history, though it has to be seen together with the dramatic events that preceded it, namely: his bitter passion and death on the Cross. Together, they constitute the “Paschal Mystery,” which is the “global” saving event, thanks to which all sins have been expiated by our Redeemer Jesus Christ, and the doors of heaven have been laid open by him for all mankind. Of all the events in his life, starting with his conception and birth, then his baptism, the endless miracles he performed and all the way to the institution of the Eucharist and his death on Calvary, the most decisive of all is his resurrection. In fact, as St. Paul puts it in his First Letter to the Corinthians, “if Christ has not been raised, then empty is our preaching; empty, too, is your faith; you are still in your sins” (1 Cor 15:14.17). Rightly the Church emphasizes the primacy of the Resurrection as it decks it with numerous “Alleluias!” and commemorates it on Easter Sunday and throughout the Easter season. The Easter period includes also Christ’s ascension into heaven and the descent of the Holy Spirit. All these liturgical solemnities are not only commemorations of basic historical events, but are also as many challenges addressed to all believers to see to it that their message is both fully understood and lived out. Easter then and the entire Easter season are wonderful opportunities to re-live these very important events in the life of Christ and also to experience them in our own lives, with particular thanks to their liturgical celebrations.

**Divine Mercy Sunday April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at Our Lady Queen of Peace in Bobcaygeon**

The Lord expressed His will with regard to this feast in His very first revelation to St. Faustina. The most comprehensive revelation can be found in her *Diary* entry 699:

*My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.*
