From the Desk of the Pastor...

Today is a good time to think about our vocation – what is it that we are doing and how well are we doing it? Notice that there is a difference between a vocation and a job. Our job is what we do and are paid for to provide for ourselves (and our family). Vocation comes from the Latin word, “**Vocare**”, which means “to call.” Our vocation is what God is calling us to do with our life, with our relationship with God, with our dealings with others.

Because of our relationship with God (especially through baptism), all of us have a vocation, a calling. We are called to be part of the family of God, the sheep of the Lord Jesus’ flock. God has already given us more than what we are worth. As sinners, we are not worthy of the price that Jesus paid to reconcile us. The price Jesus paid was His own death. Yet because we have received the benefits of the cost He has already paid, we are to live out our calling without expecting any monetary rewards.

And what exactly does our vocation entail? There are certain common elements of our vocations, but each one of us has a slightly unique way we are to perform the mission assigned to us. One of the common elements of our vocations is that we are called to go out to the lost sheep of God and compassionately minister to serve those who need to know that Jesus has paid the price – has given His life – for them. Another aspect that is similar in all our vocations is that we are to announce the Good News without counting the cost to ourselves, for we have already received more than we could ever earn through any of our own workings. Each of us, however, is to live out our vocation in a unique, personal way, since we each have special talents and abilities, and we will be ministering and serving different people who come into our lives. Some of us are called to the vocation of being a loving wife/husband and a parent to our children. Others are living out their calling as single individuals. We are all placed in different work environments so that we can minister and live out our vocation while we earn our livelihood. Our vocation, however, should be our primary focus as we do our job. We should think of our place of employment as the field in which we are called to help the Master of the harvest. Jesus has placed us in a particular field so that we can help Him reap the harvest where we have been placed.

This does not mean we have to go around and start preaching (although this is great and will make a difference). Our daily living and our treatment of others should be the pulpit from which we proclaim God’s love and compassion for others. We need to look at others with the same compassion Jesus looked out at the crowds and realized they were like sheep without a shepherd. Our vocation should lead us to help shepherd them back to the fold of the Good Shepherd Himself, our Lord Jesus. Through the guidance and strength of the Holy Spirit, may we humbly respond to God’s call of working every day with His Son in His flock and harvest.
