


From the desk of the pastor...

Max Lucado in his, *A Gentle Thunder*, narrated about a man who dared God to speak: "Burn the bush like you did for Moses, God. And I will follow. Collapse the wall like you did for Joshua, God. And I will fight. Still the waves like you did on Galilee, God. And I will listen."

And God heard the man, so God answered. He sent fire, not for a bush but for a church. He brought down a wall, not of brick but of sin. He stilled a storm, not of sea but of soul. And God waited for the man to respond. And He waited... And waited... And waited... But the man was looking at bushes, not hearts; bricks and not lives; sea and not souls, he decided that God had done nothing.

Finally he looked to God and asked: "Have you lost your power?" And God looked at him and said: "Have you lost your hearing?"

God's Kingdom is difficult to understand because even Jesus Himself is often illusive and does not, in absolute manner, explain it. Rather, He speaks in parables.

The parable is about different responses of different types of people and their hearts to God's Kingdom. The seeds of God's Kingdom and His Words are sown in us. But, some have *Hardened Hearts*. There's no openness at all. For them the word of God, the Church and the sacraments are outdated, old-fashioned, irrelevant, unnecessary, unimportant and have nothing to do with their lives.

Others have *the Distracted Hearts*. These people have surface level heart and there is a little openness. There is no real commitment.

Still others have *the Defeated Heart*. It represents an insecure heart. There is openness but the heart has many concerns. These people are selfish. Finally, fourth is *the Hopeful and Joyful Heart*. These people have generous and wide open hearts. They hear the word of God and respond into it by applying it to themselves and bear fruits of good deeds.

MASS INTENTIONS UPDATE FOR OUR LADY QUEEN OF PEACE & ST. ALOYSIUS

What is a 'Mass Intention'?

The tradition of Masses offered for the intentions of living or deceased loved ones originated in the very early Church and continues to be an important Catholic practice. For us who believe that the Mass is the perfect prayer, no greater gift can be offered for our loved ones, living and deceased, who may still need the help of our prayers. Priests are under a strict obligation to remember in a special way the person for whom the Mass is being offered.

Masses are often requested for a loved one who has recently died or on the anniversary of a death. However, the gift of a Mass intention is also a wonderful way to offer prayers on the event of a wedding anniversary, a birthday, an anniversary of ordination or entrance into religious life. Masses may also be offered for the intentions of a person about to undergo surgery, who is recuperating from an illness, who wishes to overcome addiction, sin or has some other special need. Masses may be offered in thanksgiving for blessings, family, health and answer to prayers.

Cost of a Mass Intention

We offer announced or unannounced Masses for your loved ones. According to diocesan guidelines the standard offering for an "Announced Mass" Intention is \$20.00. An "Unannounced Mass" Intention can be offered for \$10.00. Of course, no one "purchases" a Mass - no one Mass "belongs" to any one person. The Mass is offered for all. But it is permissible for a priest to celebrate the Mass for any intention. Priests can offer more than one intention at a Mass on any given day. Please note that \$5 of each Mass intention collected is deposited to the 'Priest Benefit Fund'.

"Announced" vs "Unannounced" Mass

An Announced Mass will be placed on a scheduled day and time and be listed in the bulletin. The intention is also mentioned in the Prayers of the Faithful during the Mass. An Unannounced Mass means the intentions Are not announced, but are known to the priest and included in his celebration of the Mass. They will be mentioned in the Prayers of the Faithful on the day the intention is offered. A Mass Card can be provided indicating the intention to be celebrated and the date and time of the Mass.


How to Purchase a Mass Intention
