From the desk of the pastor...

Friends,

If we are to summarize the message of the Kingdom of God as preached and witnessed by Jesus, it is as simple as this: God loves us so much, therefore, we must also love one another.

In our Gospel reading this Fifth Sunday of Easter, Jesus told His disciples and He tells us today: “As I have loved you, so you also should love one another! This is how all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.” (John 13:34-35)

Now, as He is about to return to His Father in heaven, Jesus repeats this mandate to love one another. It is by love that we will be identified as true followers of Jesus. Jesus now gives us a new way of measuring love of neighbour: Love them as Jesus has loved us. Put simply: Love them unconditionally. This is how we shall be rightfully called “followers of Jesus Christ.”

Following Jesus is never easy. There are times when we are tempted to give up and lose hope. There is a great temptation to take the easy road. But that road will lead us not to God but to sin.

The early Christians experienced this and in our First Reading today, we hear Paul and Barnabas’ exhortation: “It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God.” (Acts 14:22) Without God’s love and providence, we will not be able to survive life’s challenges. It is through the love of God that we are strengthened and urged to love without limits.

Christian faith is about living in the truth even if it hurts. Christian faith is about standing up for what is right and good. Christian life is about following Jesus and relying on His grace so that we will remain strong even in the midst of darkness and sin. Let us love one another as Christ loved us. Love is the key to live fully in the light of Christ. This is our key to the path of goodness and justice.
