**From the desk of the pastor...**

At every stage in human history, in every country today, there are social, moral and spiritual situations that resemble that of the Israelites at the time of the Exile in Babylon. Everywhere there is misery, corruption, suffering and even despair. A culture of death and despondency seems to prevail. So many scattered dry bones in the desert of life. So many shattered dreams. So many wilted lives...

Many solutions are proposed to solve the innumerable problems that vex mankind and our country. Some proposals are good, some are controversial or even counterproductive. But over and above our plans – even the best – we have to remember the warning of the psalmist: “If the Lord does not build the house, in vain do its builders labour.” We may have wonderful plans and work hard, but unless the Lord blesses our plans and gives us strength to carry them out, nothing worthwhile will happen.
