From the desk of the pastor...

Most of us are familiar with the word “Advent.” But many of us sometimes forget its meaning. Advent means “coming.” Who is coming? For whom is He coming? The Gospel today is clear about this.

Even little children know that Jesus is the one who is coming for them and for us all. It is about the birth of the God-Child who came to us one night in Bethlehem of Judah more than 2000 years ago. Where and under what kind of circumstances does this birth take place? In a manger that was used for domestic animals, the Son of God comes to us.

Some children love listening to the story of the little boy of Bethlehem, and the adults—at least some of them—love being part of that same joy, and would even like to be children once again at least on Christmas Day.

Advent time prepares us to fully participate in the mystery and joy of Christmas every year. It also prepares us for that personal encounter with God, face to face, at the end of our earthly journey.

It is important, therefore, to keep in mind that the coming of Jesus in Bethlehem and His last coming, are but one event that extends itself throughout history. Not two different comings but one.

Christian hope is synthesized and ends at Advent. It permeates the entire life of the Christian person. Advent deepens our desire to see Christ come back. It is important for us to have this longing for the Lord's return, but in His fullness. Therefore, we continue to pray constantly saying, “Your kingdom come.”

Not only at Christmas time, but in every celebration of this Eucharistic banquet, is made visible the joyful mystery of the coming and presence of Christ among us. This is the reason to repeat and insist over and over the need to experience Jesus coming. It is through this persistent waiting and continuous experience that this image of God, in which we were created by love in Jesus Christ, will come to full maturity.
