From the desk of the pastor...

It's First Sunday of Lent!

The first Sunday of Lent is about temptation. Temptation is a fact of life. It's everywhere. Jesus shows us that temptation cannot be avoided. Jesus even went out to the desert to be tempted.

The Church tells us at the beginning of Lent that we need to seek God's help in facing the temptations that we encounter in our lives.

Lent is not so much about doing something extra for God as it is about letting God do something extra for us. It is a time for turning to God for the help we need in dealing with the temptations we have to deal with every day. During this time we usually talk about three kinds of penance - **fasting, almsgiving or charity and prayer** - to arm ourselves against temptation.

Fasting is bringing some moderation into areas of our lives that we tend to overdo. When we fast, we recognize that God's love for us in giving us a body to care for. Fasting is giving up something that is not God but that takes God's place in our lives.

Charity or almsgiving is another form of penance. To be charitable we first need to attend to what the needs of other people are. Then we must find ways to help them. Development and Peace is a Canadian organization that helps our sisters and brothers in the Global South who suffer from the injustice of poverty need our financial assistance.

Finally, there is **prayer**, which is also a response to the temptation to be self-centered. God has made us, not just for our world, but also for His. The only way we can begin to be part of God's world is to pay some attention to it. That is what prayer is, paying attention to God. It is to develop a true relationship of love with God.

Lent is a time for countering the temptation to centre our lives on ourselves and our own needs. Lent is a time for us once again to face the temptations that keep us from recognizing and responding to the needs of others and from turning to God for the help we need in responding to God's call.
