From the desk of the pastor...

All of us have the opportunity to become leaders because we have people to care, to tend and to lead. For example, our pope, he is the leader of the universal church. The bishop is the leader of the local church called the Diocese. The parish priest is the leader of the parish. The Grand Knight is the leader of his parish council. And so is the CWL president; she is president of her parish CWL council. Government officials, managers, parents and others are also leaders in their own field of activities.

Every Fourth Sunday of Easter is called the Good Shepherd Sunday. It is about Jesus Christ, the Good Shepherd, who is ready to lay down His life for us, ready to defend life, ready to spread life, ready to give His whole life for His sheep everyday. A true leader models his/her leadership on the Good Shepherd.

In the John's gospel today ((Jn. 10:1-10) Jesus gives us the criteria of a true and genuine leadership.

First is dedication. A true leader is ready to give his life for all no matter what. They should not take advantage and in-flesh themselves instead they should tend and look after people's welfare.

Second criterion is knowledge. The true leader knows his/her people (John 10:3). "Knowing" in biblical term is more than intellectual knowledge. It also includes knowing them by their names, works, ambitions, plans, feelings, sharing their life's conditions, backgrounds and identifying oneself in their struggle.

Lastly is a leader must an Exemplar. A leader must be an example in his/her community by words and deeds. Have we cared enough the flock God has entrusted to us?

Our Savior, sent by the Father to reveal His merciful love, give to your Church the gift of young people who are ready to put out into the deep, to be the sign among their brothers of Your presence which renews and saves. Holy Virgin, Mother of the Redeemer, sure guide on the way towards God and towards neighbor, You who pondered his word in the depth of your heart, sustain with your motherly intercession our families and our ecclesial communities, so that they may help adolescents and young people to answer generously the call of the Lord. Amen!
