



Once there was a proud eagle perched on top of a cut banana trunk floating swiftly down a swollen river. The big bird seemed oblivious of the tremendous waterfall that lay ahead.

It so happened that a hunter was walking down a path along the river's edge. Seeing the huge bird perched on the banana trunk, the hunter clapped his hands and cried out, "Yoo-hoo, fly away... There's danger ahead!" The eagle merely shrugged his enormous wings as if to say, "Don't bother me. I know what I am doing."

As the banana stump moved closer to the waterfall, the hunter again cried out frantically gesturing, "Hey, there's a waterfall ahead!" Again, the complacent eagle merely shrugged his wings.

## Standing up to corporate power in Honduras

The *People and Planet First* campaign is about helping communities stand up to corporate power. In Honduras, as in much of the Global South, corporations often threaten and criminalize activists who speak up against their abuses.

The Lenca Indigenous leader Víctor Vásquez was imprisoned for the corporate takeover of his people's ancestral territory.

Development and Peace's partner, the Honduran Centre for the Promotion of Community Development (CEHPRODEC), helped free him from jail.

Another partner, Caritas Choluteca, trains and accompanies community leaders in advocating for policies that respect human rights and the environment. Recently, they got mayoral election candidates to undertake to declare the municipality of Orocuina a mining-free zone if elected.

# **COVID-19 UPDATE**

## <u>Updates on Covid-19 Health precautions as of March 21, 2021:</u>

- Indoor masking requirements are lifted in churches, parish halls and offices starting on Monday, March 21, 2022.
- Churches can currently rent their halls, and food/drink can currently be served in halls.
- Starting Monday, March 21, all Covid-19 health precautions are lifted in parish halls
- Starting on Monday, March 21, health precautions on choir activities are lifted.
- Clergy and lay staff who have a Covid-19 close contact or who experience symptoms or test positive for the Covid-19 virus are reminded to continue following the current health unit guidelines and provincial regulations that apply to close contacts, the onset of symptoms or a positive test result.
