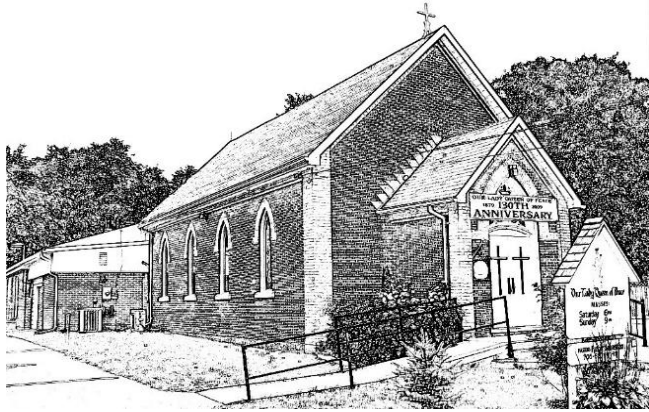

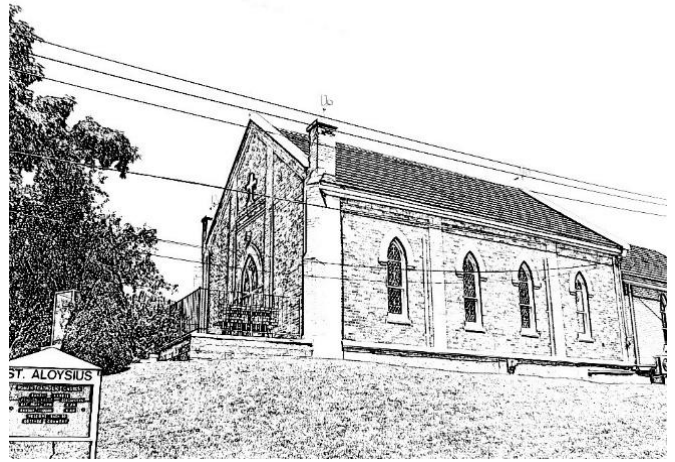

From the Desk of the Pastor...

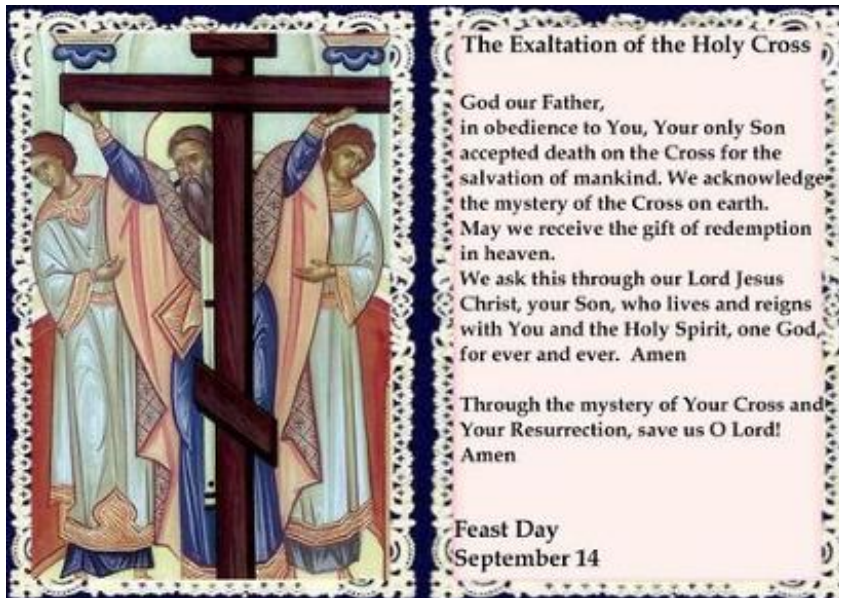
For us Catholics, the Cross is an important symbol of faith. When we were baptized, we were sealed with the Cross as our original sins are taken away, as we die with Christ in the waters of baptism and as we receive new life in him. We make the sign of the Cross as we begin and end our prayers, consecrating ourselves to God. We make the sign of the Cross at the beginning of mass to begin our celebration in the name of our Lord. In fact, we begin each day with the sign of the Cross as we acknowledge God's loving embrace and presence in all our undertakings.

Pope Benedict XVI once stated, being Christian is not the result of an ethical choice or following a lofty idea, but rather it centers upon an encounter with Christ. Our Gospel today states that God so loved the world that he gave us his only begotten Son. God wants to enter into a relationship of love with us. This love is offered through Christ, His Son, lifted high on the Cross.

We cannot remain neutral regarding the Cross of Jesus. We cannot be neutral or complacent in the way we live out our faith. Either we are with Jesus or we are against Jesus. Either we accept our Crosses in faith or we deny our Crosses. A choice is made before every action, for the actions of a Christian are none other than the testimony of how God has loved us so much that he gave His only Son, Jesus.

During our trials and sufferings, the Cross is there to give us strength, protection and hope. O Cross of Christ, you are the glorious sign of victory! Through the power of the Cross, may we all share in the triumph of Christ Jesus.
