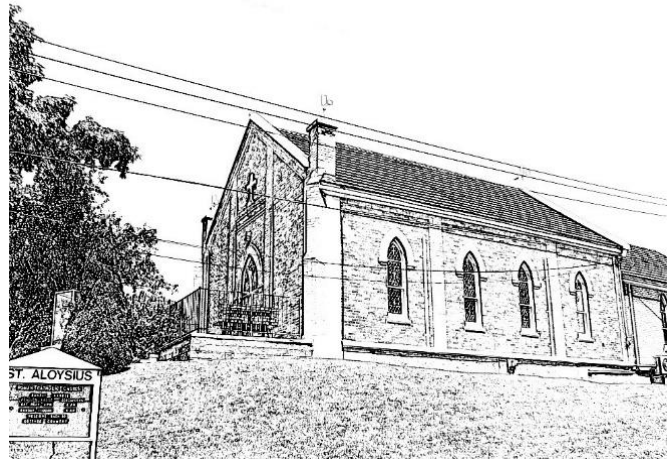

From the desk of the pastor...

The gospel story relates about Peter whose faith also faltered. Walking on the water to meet the Lord and seeing the big waves, he got scared. He started to sink and cried out, “Lord, save me!” Jesus censured him for his weakness. “Man of little faith, why did you doubt?” (Mt. 14:31).

As long as Peter kept his focus on the Lord, all went well. As soon as he forgot about Jesus and worried about the wind, he began to sink. This is what faith is all about. But someone might say, “Peter was lucky because Jesus, the miracle worker, was there in flesh and blood. But for us who have lived thousands of centuries later, we are not as lucky and blessed.”

Jesus, however, told His apostles: “Blessed are those who have not seen (Me) but believe.” (John 20:29). Anyway, we are asked by God to trust in Him even when the big waves threaten our faith. And these can be a serious financial problem, a life threatening sickness, a floundering business or an unjust treatment at home or at work.

What’s our attitude when those waves or life crises buffet us? Would we be scared like Peter and despair? Would we hold on to the Lord even if we don’t understand his plan?

Faith is not escapism. It does not mean neglecting or escaping from our responsibility and praying that God will solve our problems and difficulties which, by the way, is a common attitude among many.

Yes, we must have faith in God, but we must also have faith in ourselves by doing our part. “God helps those who help themselves,” states the wise dictum. In the words of the great Saint Augustine: “Pray as if everything depended on God; work as if everything depended on you.”

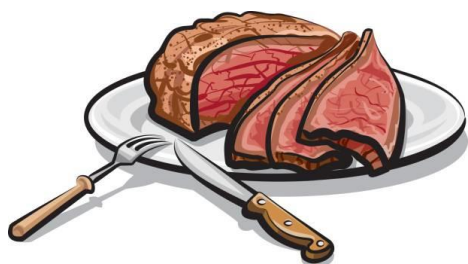

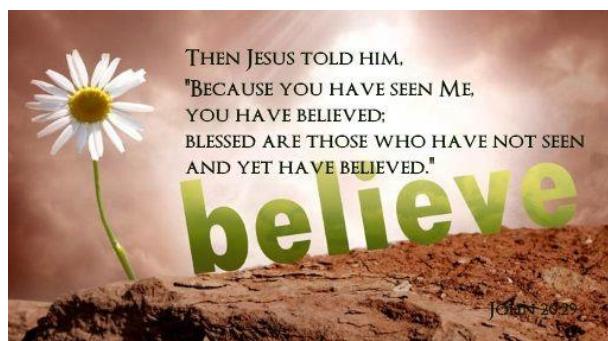
