



#### From the Desk of the Pastor...

Today's Gospel (Mk. 6, 30-34) tells us that Jesus gathers His weary disciples to a deserted place "to rest a while." Don't we all need to "rest a while?" When we feel tired and exhausted, we need to take a rest. We must accept our human limitations. We are not gods. Human as we are, we need to withdraw from our worldly concerns once in a while, to recharge and then go back again. To do otherwise is folly. The Lord reminds us that life is not so much about going fast or far, but going to the heart.

The bottom line is that we are just instruments, unworthy ones at that. In other words, it is God's work, not ours. More than being so focused on the work of God, let us focus on the God of our work. Let us focus on the God who called us for a mission. We are important, yes, but none of us are indispensable in God's eyes.

When talking to people, avoid these three possible turn-off questions: "What are you doing here?" "Anything I can do for you?" "When are you going?" If you have the tendency to fire away these questions, especially to people who come to you unannounced or who come to do nothing, you have fallen into the trap the "heresy of work." It's all right for people to just be, to take time and to stay.

## July 2024 Prayer Intentions: For pastoral care of the sick

The Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network has released the list of prayer intentions set by Pope Francis for the year 2024. Each month, Pope Francis asks Catholics around the world to pray for a specific intention.

"Let us pray that the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick grant the Lord's strength to those who receive it and to their loved ones, and that it may become for everyone an ever more visible sign of compassion and hope." – Pope Francis

The Pope is inviting the Church to pray for the pastoral care of the sick during the month of July 2024. In a recent video, he recalled that the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not only for people at death's doorstep. "If someone thinks that a priest offering the sacrament means that they are about to die", said the Pope, "they have embraced a hopeless vision". "Let us remember that the Anointing of the Sick is one of the 'sacraments of healing,' of 'restoration,' that heals the spirit," said the Pope. He added that the sacrament is always available for people who are ill, especially the elderly.

"When a person is very ill," he said, "it's advisable to give them the Anointing of the Sick." Pope Francis concluded by praying that the sacrament may become a more visible sign of compassion and hope.
