From the Desk of the Pastor...

During the last night of Jesus’ life, He assures His disciples, three times, that they will not be left alone: “I will ask the Father and He will give you the Spirit to be with you forever.” (John 14:16). Jesus also insists and calls them to respond with the covenant love that God is offering: “If you love me, you will keep my commandments.” (John 14:15). Jesus loved with the love that He received from His Father, so for His disciples to love in the same way, He promises to dwell with His Father and the Spirit in their hearts. St. Paul often speaks of this amazing truth: that we are the sacred place where God has chosen to dwell: “Do you know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, which you have from God?” (1 Corinthians 6:19).

Once again, for the disciples and us to share with Jesus in the intimate communion which He enjoys with the Father and the Holy Spirit, love is the condition. This is not because God’s offer of love is conditional but because we can receive love only in love. It is our receiving that is conditional upon our love, not God’s giving. This invitation of love is open to all. The Holy Spirit touches our lives in ways which empowers us to live our faith. The Holy spirit continues to enflame our hearts that we may share in Jesus’ mission and ministry.

Jesus’ invitation continues to echo in the hearts of the faithful today. We can see people of all walks of life in the parish opening their hearts to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. We see volunteers to the different ministries of the church, humble parishioners stepping up to attend the physical welfare of the needy and individuals going out of their way to give witness to their faith. These are concrete indicators that the Holy Spirit continues the work of instructing, enlightening and empowering the Church.

Therefore, brethren, if your heart is burning with love of the Church, you have the passion of serving the Parish in every possible way and deeply inspired by Jesus’ love to contribute or be part, in any way, for the building up of the community, then, Jesus’ mission and ministry lives and continues. Let us always remember that to share in this intimate communion with the Divine Trinity, Jesus’ only condition is LOVE.



- 5 Announce the first mystery and recite the Our Father.
- 6 Recite ten Hail Marys.
- 7 Recite the Glory Be and the Fatima Prayer.
- 8 Announce the second mystery. Recite the Our Father and repeat the steps through the rosary.
- 9 After completing the mysteries, recite the Hail Holy Queen & end with the Sign of the Cross.

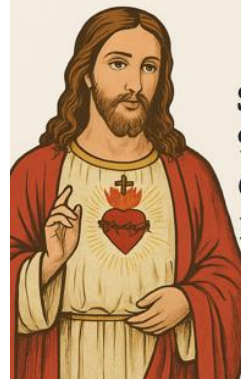
The 12th Annual Walking Pilgrimage will take place August 9-15th.
