From the desk of the pastor...

Dear Friends,

The readings this weekend speak of the essential message of Jesus' earthly ministry – Love. Last Sunday, Jesus bid His disciples to love one another as He has loved them.

In the same Gospel, John the Evangelist records one of the last messages of Jesus before His ascension into heaven. Here, Jesus reassures His friends that they will not be left orphans. Jesus will continue to be with them and guide them as they continue the mission he has begun. This will be fulfilled in and through the guidance of the Holy Spirit, whom he will send as the "Paraclete," a guide, a counselor who will teach them all things, and bring to their remembrance all that Jesus has said to them.

Through the power of the Holy Spirit, the disciples will preach the Good News of the Kingdom to all the ends of the earth. They will tell the world about the love of God in Jesus Christ.

We continue the work of the apostles. We are modern-day apostles of Jesus Christ. Jesus speaks to us through our liturgy and urges us with the same message he gave to His disciples 2,000 years ago: "If a man loves me, he will keep My word, and My Father will love Him, and we will come to Him and make our home with Him." (John 14:23)

The love of Christ urges us to do what God wants us to do. This love, however, is not "one way." For if we love God and obey his will, peace will be upon us. This peace, which the world cannot offer, will bring us lasting happiness. If we do this, we shall inherit the fullness of God's blessings.
