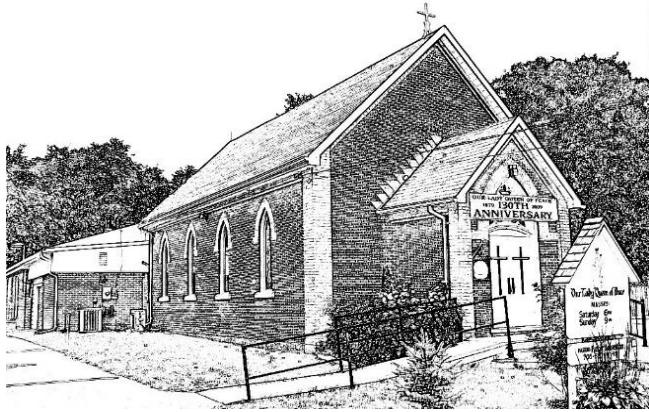

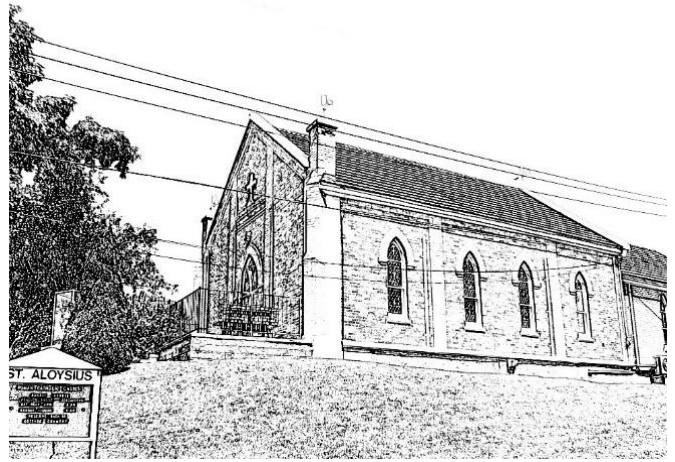

**From the desk of the pastor...**

Which commandment of the law is the greatest: To love God or to love our fellowmen? Both views have their staunch defenders. The parish council of a certain church decided to renovate their old church to provide a worthy celebration of the liturgy.

When the leaders learned of the big project, they vigorously protested, saying, "It's a scandal to beautify the surroundings while the poor are suffering from lack of shelter!" The money could be used instead to finance social action projects like providing housing for the poor.

This incident illustrates two sharply opposed views of Christian faith: One we may call the vertical dimension; the other, horizontal.

Those who hold the vertical view say that our religion has to do with God or with nothing at all. Their concern is the salvation and sanctification of souls.

Advocates of the horizontal view, on the other hand, say it is a scandal to build magnificent edifices when people lack the basic necessities. They claim that Jesus was the friend of the poor and the downtrodden.

Which of these two views is correct? Where does the true Christian stand?

Jesus says that there's only one greatest commandment but, like a coin, there are two sides: Love of God and love of one's neighbour. Authentic discipleship consists not in espousing one extreme view to the exclusion of the other but in the pursuit of both. It is hard to understand, for instance, a Christian who goes to church regularly but at the same time is harsh, unkind and merciless to his or her workers or involved in immoral practices.

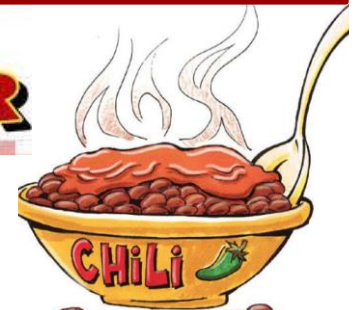
Although Christ was totally immersed in His work of preaching, teaching, healing, He never forgot to turn to the Father in prayer. In Christ we find the vertical and the horizontal in wonderful harmony. We are called to combine and live the vertical and horizontal dimensions of our faith. That is where Jesus lived.

**ALL SAINTS & ALL SOULS DAY**

Fr. John will be celebrating one mass each day on November 1<sup>st</sup> & November 2<sup>nd</sup>. Please plan to attend either church to observe All Saints & All Souls Day celebrations.

**All Saints Day – Wednesday November 1<sup>st</sup> at 9:00 a.m. at St. Aloysius**  
**All Souls Day – Thursday November 2<sup>nd</sup> at 1:00 p.m. at Our Lady Queen of Peace**

All Hallows' Day, the Solemnity of All Saints, or All Saints' Day is a celebration of all Catholic saints held on November 1 each year. "On this solemnity, we recall the holy men and women who, having completed their earthly journeys, now live forever with God. These saints, though not canonized, offer us models of abiding faith and love of God and neighbour" (Essential Guide to Seasons and Saints, 109).

The Church teaches that by imitating the virtues lived by the saints, the saints bring us closer to Christ. When we ask the saints to pray for us, we ask them to join their wills with the will of God and intercede for us here on earth. This is the Communion of Saints which we profess every Sunday in the Creed. (Source: USCCB)

All Souls' Day, also known as "The Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed" is observed on Nov. 2. The faithful on earth can assist these purgatorial souls in attaining heaven through prayer, good work and the offering of Mass. At Mass on All Souls' Day, we pray that through Christ's loving mercy, God's "departed servants...may be granted pardon and peace and be brought to the joy of God's eternal home. All Souls Day is an especially rich cultural experience for Hispanic/Latino Catholics, who call it "Día de los Muertos" or "The Day of the Dead."
