

From the Desk of the Pastor...

Do you know that we, Christians, are all called to be Missionaries? How can we live and maintain our missionary spirit.

Our Gospel today tells us about a poor widow who keeps on asking an unjust judge to rule in her favour. The widow's determination, courage and persistence wears down the judge's resistance. The parable shows us how enduring prayer is important in our Christian life every day. In the second reading, from St. Paul's second letter to Timothy, we hear about the enduring life-giving power of Scripture. Paul tells Timothy that God's breath animates the words of Scripture. God's word is alive and filled with the Holy Spirit. God's word is capable of teaching us, challenging us, correcting us and sanctifying us.

As we celebrate today the World Mission Sunday, it is also appropriate to hear about persistent prayer and the Word of God. Missionaries throughout the world follow the steps of the widow and Timothy in our readings today. They persist in prayer and faith even in the midst of challenges, obstacles and oppression. They are fed by God's word. Missionaries need our help and our prayers, which is why we observe World Mission Sunday each year to promote the work of the missions and evangelization in our Church.

The late Pope Francis had stated numerous times that maintaining a missionary spirit is important for us as a Church. He said that we should be Missionaries of Hope among all Peoples. He reminds individual Christians and the entire community of the Church of our fundamental vocation to be messengers and builders of hope as we directly follow in the footsteps of Christ. Just like the example of St Therese of Lisieux, a Carmelite nun who has a heart for the missions and always prayed for the missions and supported missionaries in different ways. She is now one of the patron saints of the missions, even though she never was sent to a foreign land as a missionary.

Do we see ourselves as messengers of hope and individuals with missionary spirit in our world that is often filled with so much darkness and confusion?

November 2

On this day, Holy Mother Church remembers and prays for all souls who have departed this life marked by the sign of faith. Through the Sacrifice of the Mass, prayers, and works of mercy, we implore God's mercy for those in Purgatory, that they may soon behold His face in glory.

A Brief History

The custom of praying for the dead dates to the early Church, when Christians remembered the departed during the Eucharistic sacrifice.

All Saints' Day was established by Pope Gregory IV in the 9th century to honor the entire communion of saints.

All Souls' Day, introduced by St. Odilo of Cluny in the 10th century, was set aside to intercede for all the faithful departed. Together, these feasts express our belief in the

Communion of Saints — the Church Triumphant, Suffering, and Militant.
